

For M1 students, please find below some useful information for the smooth running of your school year. These information are also explained on your **CAMPUS VIRTUEL** (virtual campus), your digital platform where you can find your administrative file, your schedule, your educational information, your grades... You will have access to it once your inscription is completed.

1. One week of fast track is scheduled **from the 11th to the 15th of September for non-manager students**, which means students who haven't followed 3 years of management studies before their M1 at Kedge BS. This week is mandatory and includes 30 hours of courses : Human Ressources, Marketing, Finance and Strategy. If you have been identified as a non-manager student, you will directly receive a notification from your program.
2. If you're interested in doing an exchange semester abroad, please note that a video presentation will take place. You will have access to this video directly from home, your internship or vacation place. A presentation will be scheduled during the intake week, where all the details will be explained. Careful, time flies and it's mandatory to get your TOEFL Ibt score (ETS website) before the 1st day of school in order to apply for the exchange program. The score must be at least 90.
3. During the intake week, you will have to make several choices regarding your school year. All the details will be explained during a presentation by your director and the program team. They will define **your schedule**, which means that you will have access to your final schedule once you made your choices.

You will personalize your courses with :

- The possibility to add to your M1 some classes to improve your English level
- The opportunity to follow your favorite course online :
  - Bordeaux (between a course of complexity, HR, digital skills or finance reconsidered. Please note that the courses are taught in English and French except finance reconsidered which is only taught in French)
  - Marseille (the same as Bordeaux with an extra course in Finance)
- A personalization of one part of your semester 1 by choosing between the P1, P2 or P3.

**Intake :**

- Full time : the 18th of September 2017 in Bordeaux and Marseille
- Work/study training program : the 18th of September 2017 in Marseille and the 25th of September 2017 in Bordeaux (for the students from Bordeaux and Paris)

The MAI program will start on the 9th of Octobre 2017

Be careful, the intake for M1 and MAI students from Paris will take place in Bordeaux.
