

THE STUDENT SOCIAL SECURITY

Only if you are an international student from outside the European Union, Switzerland and Quebec: upload your social security certificate.

This document is compulsory to get your school certificate and student card.

Being affiliated to the social security is compulsory and essential. This affiliation will cover all your medical expenses throughout your studies.

In order to proceed with the affiliation, please follow the following steps:

Step 1/ Register on the dedicated website: etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr (opens on July 1st)

- a- Fill the following information in: Last name, first name, date and country of birth, email address, postal address in France and phone number.
- b- Upload the following documents: passport / identity card, residence permit, certified copy of birth certificate/ birth certificate stating filial Relationship, issued by the Consulate, school certificate received at the beginning of the school year, parental consent if you are under 16 years old, bank details, and any other additional documents that might be required depending on your country of origin.

Step 2/ Create your personal space and download your temporary social security certificate

If required, upload the missing documents and download your definitive social security certificate

Step 3/ Open a personal account on ameli.fr, from there, you will have the possibility to ask for a *carte vitale* and declare your family doctor
